Key Priorities

- Ensuring service users are provided with rapid access to OST
- Supporting our service users to remain on OST through dose optimisation & community clinics
- Harm Reduction and access to NSP
- Naloxone & peer distribution
- Segmentation
- Hospital Liaison
- Outreach
- Incident reviews and embedding learnings

Access to OST

- Optimal doses of OST to encourage retention and engagement in treatment and reduce illicit use.
- Optimising treatment is the union of effective, targeted psychosocial interventions with optimal doses of OST that allow a client work towards the goals described in their care plan.
- Daily restart appointments are available across the borough
- Community prescribing clinics ensure our service users can be seen at a venue closer to their home or within their hostel

Harm Reduction

- Access to NSP in service and throughout the borough in pharmacies
- Mobile NSP through our dedicated outreach team
- NSP vending machines in 3 of our local hostels
- Encouraging peer distribution and ensuring we ask if people have enough equipment
- Wound care pathway and training for our teams
- Modified Health & Wellbeing assessments for all service users to assist recognition of late presentations for cancer and other diseases
- BBV clinics and access to onsite hep C treatment

Naloxone



- Warriors of Wigan Naloxone Peers have issued hundreds of kits to service users, families and carers, members of the public and a range of professionals across the borough
- All staff and volunteers are trained in the administration of naloxone
- Outreach team carrying naloxone and ensuring anyone they make contact with can be trained and issued with their own take home supply

Segmentation – Key Concepts, Values and Principles

Holistic Approach Considering the whole person with clinical management integrated into wider recovery journey.

Rapid Access

Focus on clinical appointment within 24 hours increases safety, reduces harm and death.

> **Trauma Informed Approach** TIA embedded in delivery.

Agility Adapting approach to respond to different client group needs.

Optimal dose Reducing risk of death and increasing ability to engage with PSIs and other interventions.

Health and Wellbeing Comorbidities identified and addressed.

Hospital Liaison

- Dedicated hospital liaison worker to support hospital inpatients and A&E attendees into treatment
- Harm reduction, overdose prevention advice & assessments available on the wards
- Ensuring Naloxone is issued to at risk service users immediately after hospital discharge
- Signposting to appropriate agencies
- Stronger together communities

Incident Reviews

- Weekly incident reviews
- Review of non-fatal overdoses to inform safety plans for service users
- Monthly Death Review meetings to identify any learnings or recommendations
- Incidents scoring over 10 (all death reviews) are reviewed by the Organisational CIRG for any wider learnings which are then cascaded appropriately
- Development of our well attended multi-agency drug related deaths panel
- Ensuring feedback and learnings are shared within our team and the wider organisation
