

INTRODUCTION:










Hello everyone. This is the first report of the new 2015-16 financial year and covers all activity from 1st April – 30th June 2015. Because of a change of data recording systems by some agencies/pharmacies, there are some missing data from this quarter's report but this will be brought up to date via aggregated totals in the report for Q2 when that's published.

Thank you to everyone who attended our recent IMS user group meeting. It was really good to hear about your experiences of using IMS. In response to your feedback, we've already updated the IMS assessments screen so you can now record "0" (zero) drinking days, drinking units, AUDIT score, and number of children: of course if the client is not asked or refuses to answer, then this item should still be left blank. We are currently working on IMS to introduce more features as a result of your suggestions and some of these will be rolled out over coming months.

We are currently working on our 2014/15 annual report which following feedback from commissioners will for the first time include analysis of client outcomes, so as always it's important that you continue to complete the client assessments screen as fully as possible, and enter your client wellbeing reviews at least once every six months.

Since the start of quarter 1 we've had another three services begin using IMS online, and in addition another three local authority areas have started using electronic data reporting for Pharmacy needle exchanges, so you may notice additional services appearing on this quarterly report as the year rolls on. Thanks as always for your commitment to IMS which continues to go from strength to strength and reflect the good work that goes on within your services.

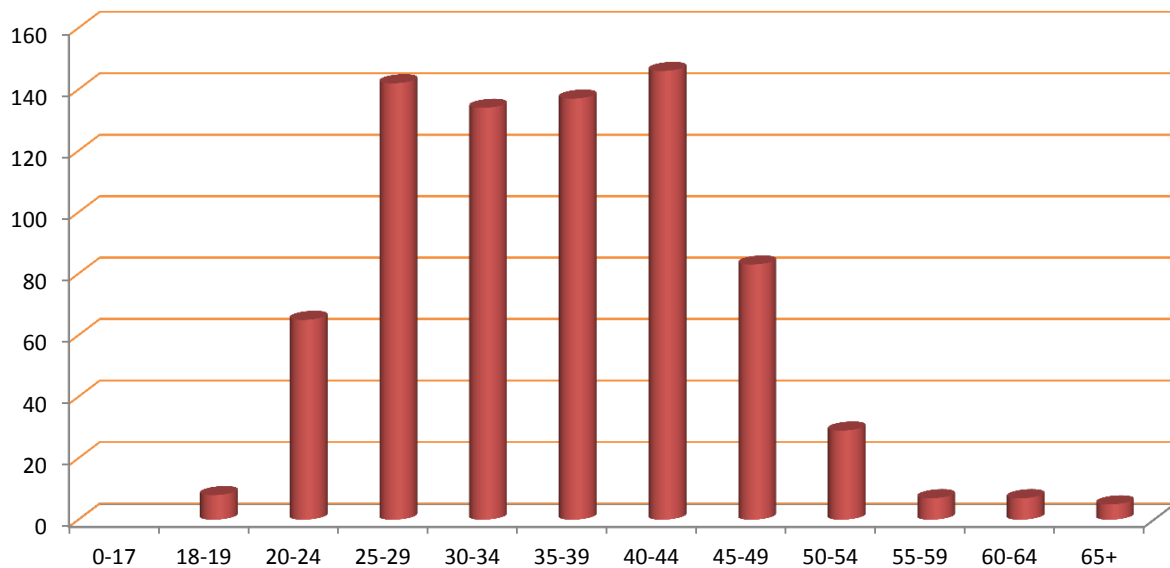

ADDITIONAL NOTES

The figure for those accessing services includes all individuals who had an intervention, an onward referral, a well being review, a health screening, or a syringe exchange transaction during the quarter.

The number of individuals shown Year to Date (YTD) is not necessarily a sum of the quarterly figures as the same individual may have presented in more than one quarter, but they will only be counted once in the YTD number. Likewise the Local Authority total is less than a sum of the agency figures where an individual has presented at multiple services during the period.

The activity summary shows the number of activities delivered by each service.

The Year to Date (YTD) activity figure is cumulative and should represent the sum of each quarterly figure, unless any retrospective changes are made to the data by the agency following their quarterly data submission.

The client review data section includes all clients who have accesses services at any time during the current year to date, and details information that is collected in the client assesment review, such as Primary Substance of use, Accomodation status, Employment Status, and Parental status.

Where the client has multiple assessments completed, only the last completed assessment has been used.
